

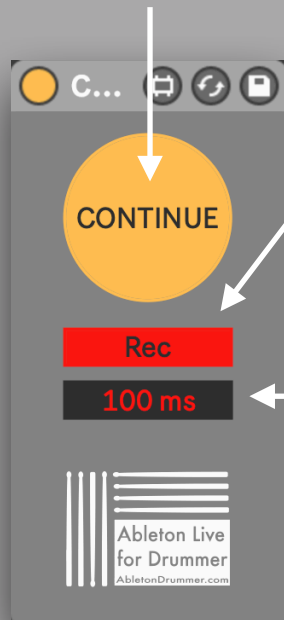
Continue Play (in Arrangement)

This device combines 3 functions to be triggered via one KEY (or one MIDI controller button):

- Stop transport
- Start transport from stop point
- (re-)activate recording for Arrangement View

This device is handy when you work in Ableton Lives Arrangement View. When starting the playback it will start from the point where the "flashing insert marker" is set to. In some use cases you want to start the playback from the point you stopped it. Natively this can be achieved with the key combination: "Shift" + "Space" only. To be able to do this with only one key or a MIDI controller you can use the "Continue Play". If you are recording in Arrangement View you can automate that recording will be switched on when you start playback via this M4L device as well.

Click (or MIDI/Key Map) here to STOP the transport playing and to CONTINUE playing from the stop point in arrangement view.



Switch on "Rec" to have "Arrangement Record" automatically activated when CONTINUE playback is triggered.

The automated "Rec" trigger needs to be delayed and playback needs to be playing already. Here you can set the time it will be delayed.

IMPORTANT:

If the delay time is set to low the playback will start from the "flashing insert marker" and not from the arrangements stop-point -in this case: JUST INCREASE THE DELAY TIME!
